# What do you Smell?





The anesthesiologist will put a mask up to your nose and ask you what do you smell?



### Recovery



When you wake up, you will be in your own special room.

As soon as you come out of surgery, the nurse will call your family to come and sit with you.



### Waking up



When you wake up you will have an IV.

It is like a "little straw" in your hand.

This allows you to have liquids until you are ready to drink on your own.

Once you drink, the nurse will slide it out and give you a band-aid.
